**ANZAC Day Service – Monday 25 April 2022**

Calvary Students from **all year levels** are invited to represent Calvary Christian College at our local Anzac Day service. This invitation extends to all Calvary students from Prep to Year 12.

**Students will meet staff at 7.15am** on Monday 25 April 2022 at **Logan East Community Neighbourhood Centre** (corner of Cinderella Drive and Vanessa Boulevard, Springwood).

The march is scheduled to begin around 7.45am, starting from the Community Centre along Cinderella Drive to the Memorial service, commencing at approximately **8.15am** at the ANZAC Memorial, in Springwood Park Cinderella Drive.
